

Chatterbox Challenge: Space

See where the Chatterbox Challenge creator takes you. Explore the amazing space themed objects in the museum using your observation skills and curiosity.

- 1 Tear across the dotted line.
- 2 With the blank side face up, fold each corner into the middle.
- 3 Turn to the printed side and fold each corner to the middle again.
- 4 Turn over again. Fold and unfold in half in both directions, then push upwards to make an umbrella-like shape.
- 6 Put your thumbs and index fingers into the four pockets and get someone to pick an action from one of the corners. Pinch and push the corners as you spell the word or count to the number.
- 6 Lift the flap to find your challenge.

6

Find something that has taken humans to space. Can you see any evidence that it has been used?

Find an object you have never seen before. Without looking at the label, tell your group what you think it is.

Find a spacecraft in the gallery. How many different materials is it made from? What different colours can you see?
