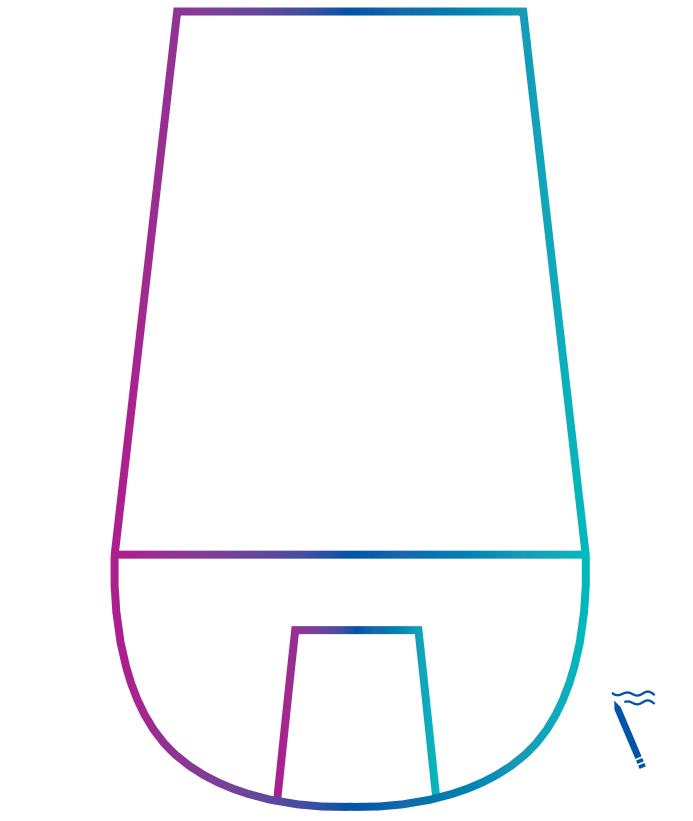

Top tips for exploring...

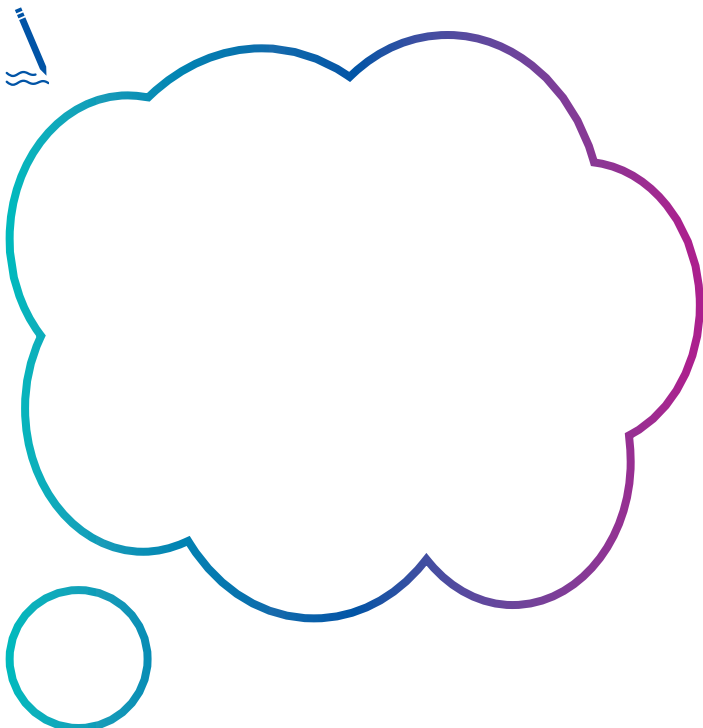

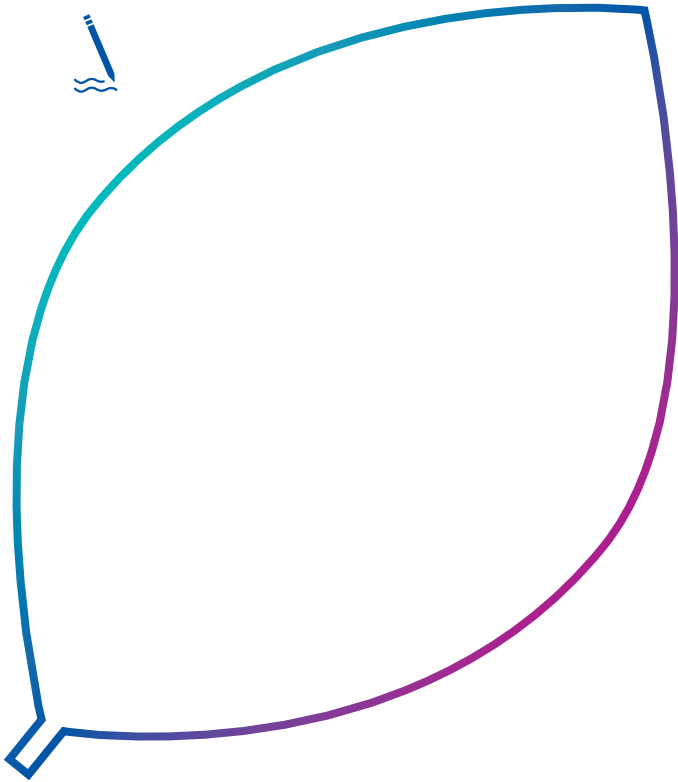
