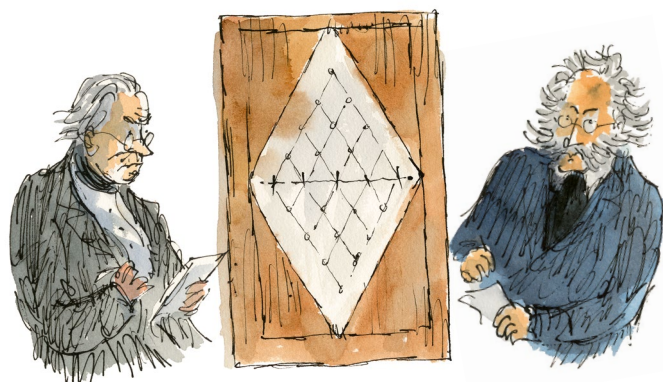

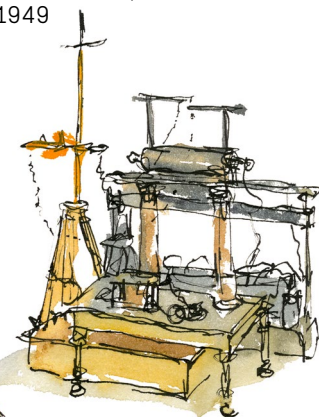

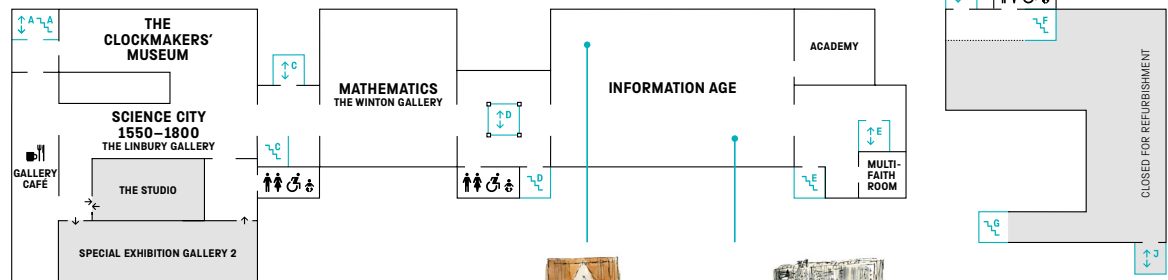

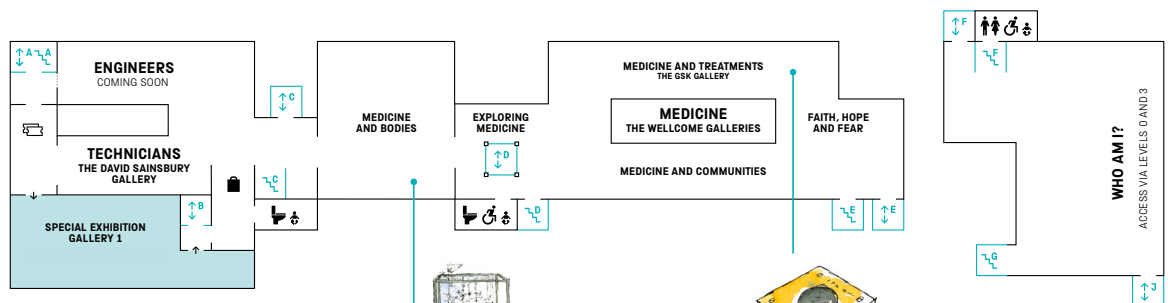

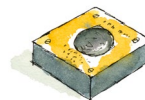

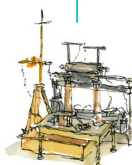
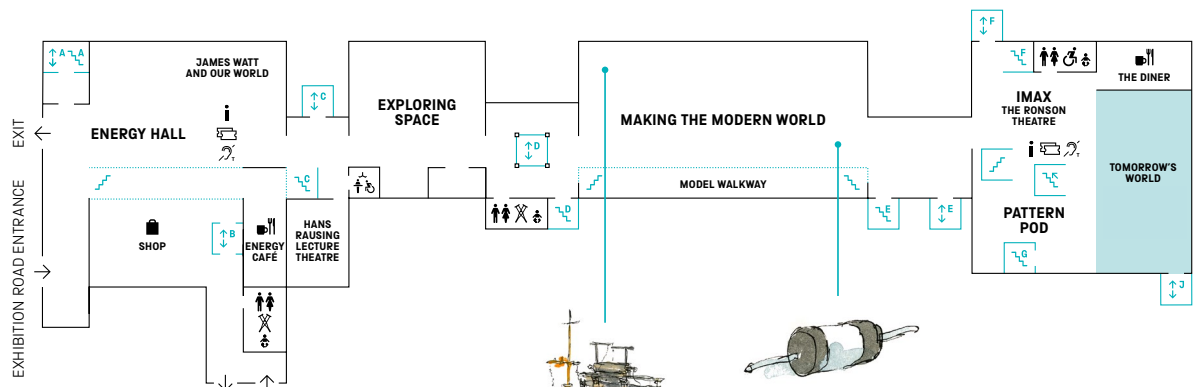


MODEL OF PIG INSULIN
