

Map of *Medicine: The Wellcome Galleries*




Medicine and bodies

This table was used in London to look at human bodies and to find out how they died.


Can you imagine what the room where this table was used would smell or sound like?

Design a bed for use in a hospital today. What would you include? Which features are important to patients and staff?




Rethinking treatments
